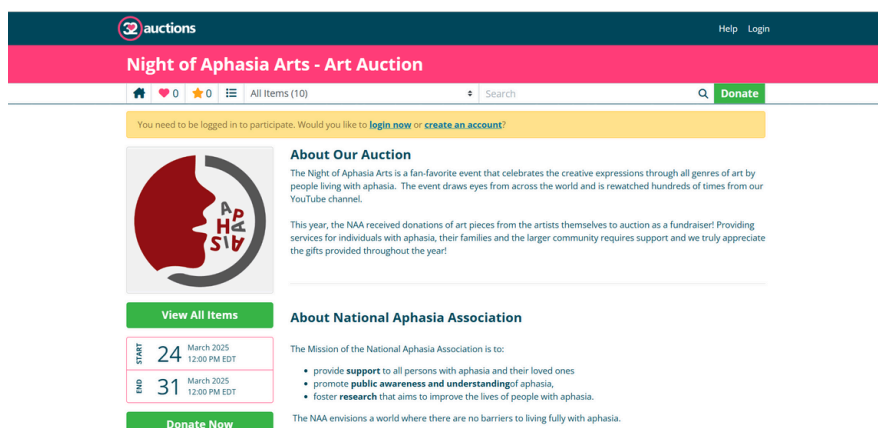

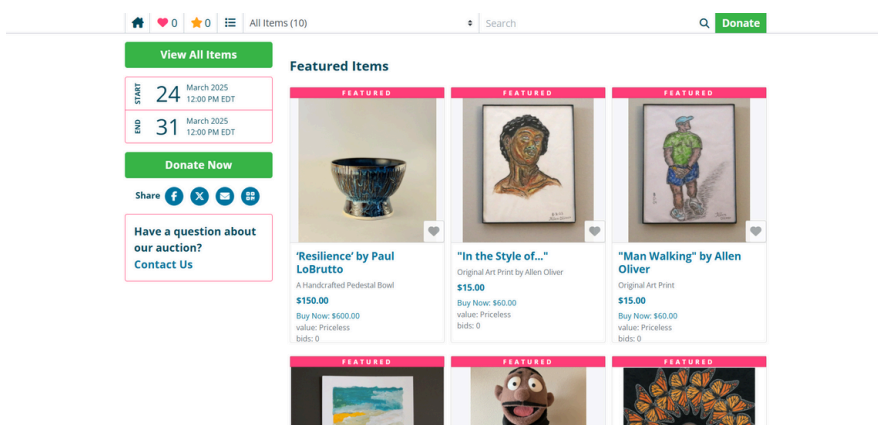

- The **intricate lines** encircling the bowl reflect the journey of his brain's recovery—his initial stroke, a seizure years later, and the ongoing process of adapting and finding new ways to feel "normal."
- Together, these elements come together in a powerful artistic statement of **strength, perseverance, and transformation**.

Paul and his wife, who run **Goose & Swan Pottery** (visit their shop), are not only dedicated artists but also passionate advocates for aphasia awareness. They generously **donate 10% of all pottery sales to the National Aphasia Association**, making their work a true labor of love.

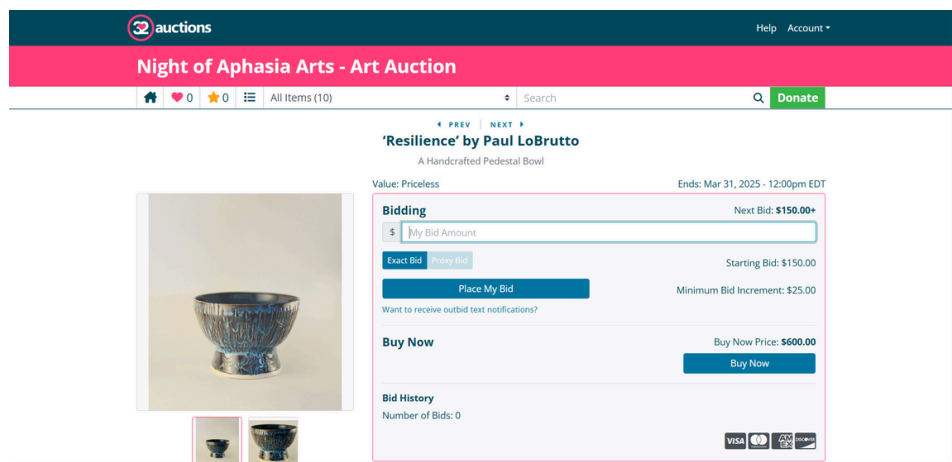
